Proposal Requirements

- Applicant must be an **undergraduate** or **graduate** student major/minoring in **English**, **Music**, **Studio** Arts, Film Studies, Theatre Arts, or Architecture
- Application file with applicant's contact information, GPA, resume, and unofficial transcript.
- An **artistic department faculty letter** displaying the faculty member's support & how they will support the artist, such as a mutual commitment to regular meetings or registering for independent study.
- A two-page proposal for the creative plan that connects the creative work to the research groups.
- A one-page budget estimating material and presentation expenses.
- Provide **work samples** in the form of:
 - 2-3 written works, 3-5 images, 2-3 video samples, OR two 5–10-minute composition samples.

Collaborative applications are welcome. Preference is given to those who have not previously participated.
